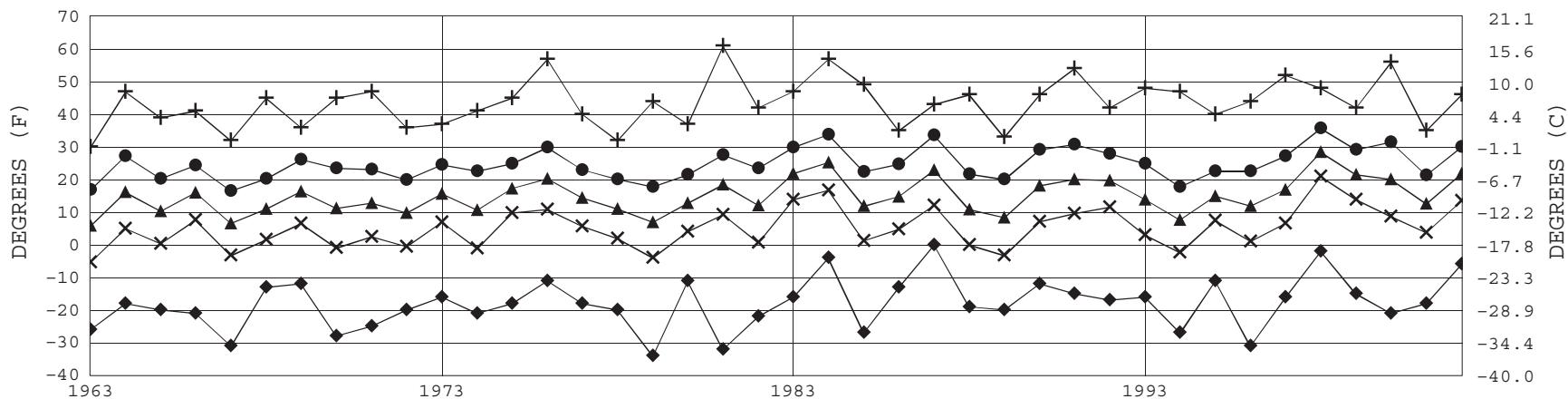

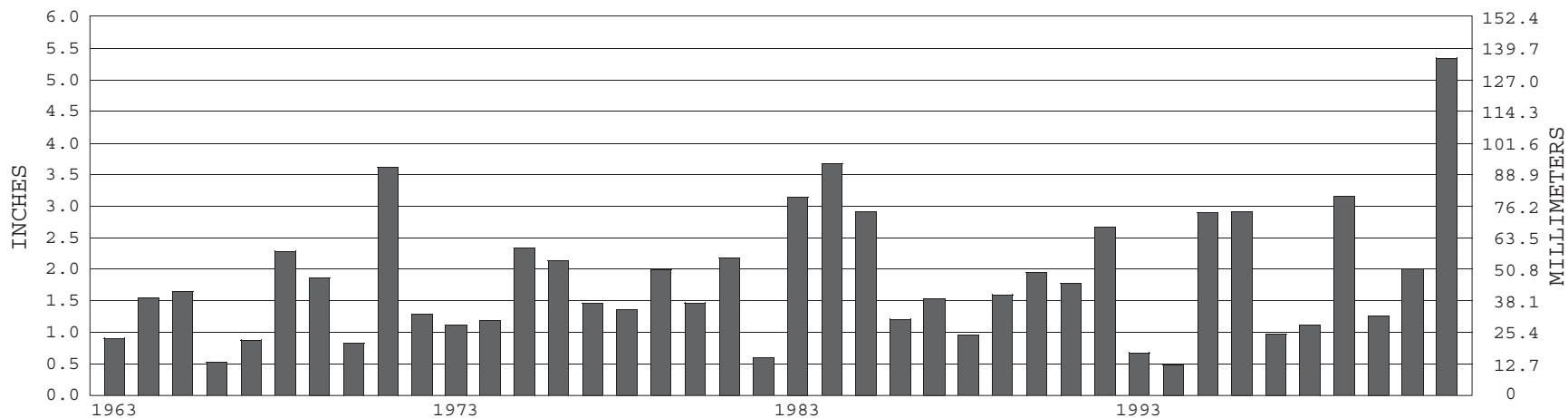
MARQUETTE, MI FEBRUARY TEMPERATURES
